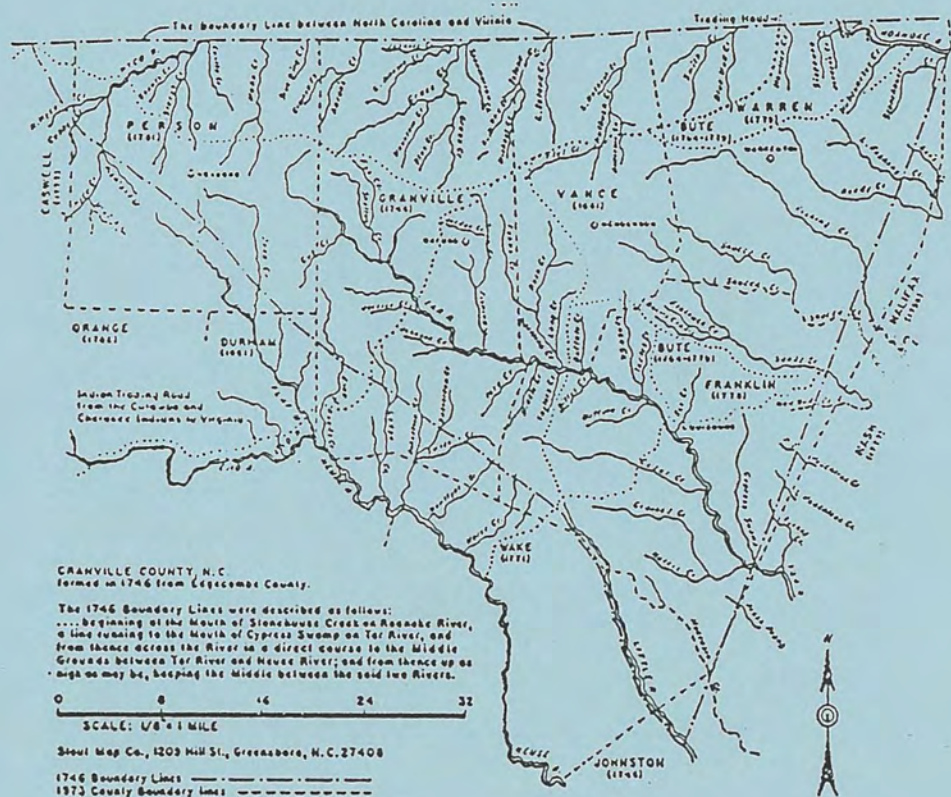

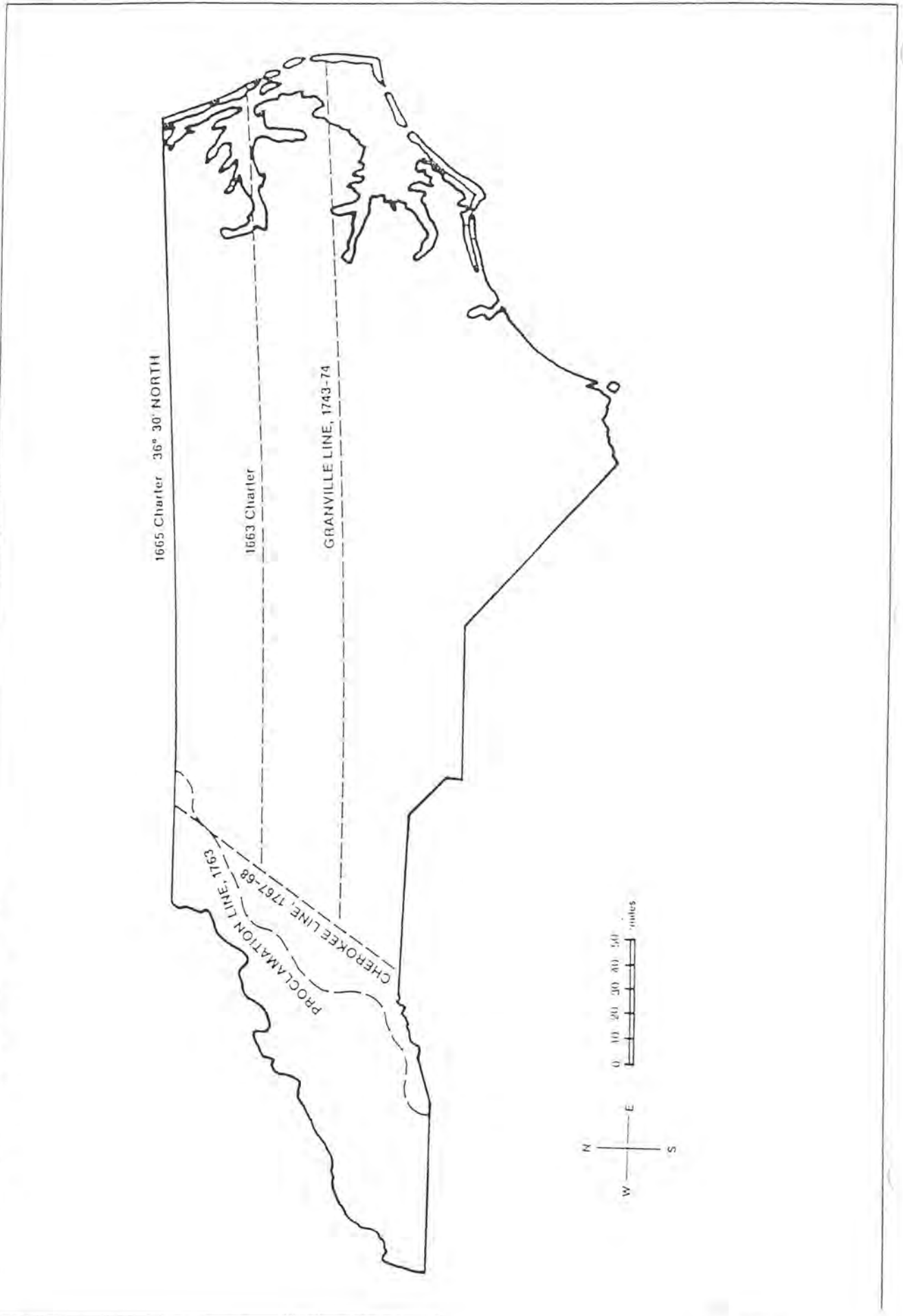

A Drive through the City of Oxford

Oxford Torchlight October 19, 1886

Come, my friends, let us take a drive around this thrifty and beautiful town, and I will tell you about it as we go along. We will start here, at the north end of College Street; how broad and pleasant it looks!

The classic name of this town is suggestive of mental culture, refinement and high art in every department, and it is well worthy of its name. We are now passing by some pleasant looking residences, and on the left, you see a handsome, spacious building of red brick - unique and tasteful in its structure, and surrounded by a magnificent grove of stately and umbrageous oaks. That is the "State Orphan Asylum", emanating first from the generous hearts of the Masons of North Carolina, and sustained by individual contribution; as well as by an appropriation from the State Legislature. It is under the control of trustees; but the present superintendent and manager, Dr. **DIXON**, is a well known and able minister, and a whole souled, christain gentleman, with a helpmeet who is an accomplished and true-hearted woman, as well as a kind mother for the orphans. They have also a corps of excellent teachers, carefully and judiciously selected. The brick building in course of erection beyond the Asylum hospital, is the Industrial School, where the orphans of both sexes will be taught how to earn a respectable living for themselves. This new house with the mansard roof, is to be the Episcopal Rectory, and when finished will be both handsome and commodious.

We will turn down this new street now and take a look at the "Granville Female Institute." A charge of Miss Bettie **CLARKE**, a most cultivated and thoroughly qualified principal, with a corps of accomplished assistants. Those numerous comfortable looking dwellings on the hill beyond, have all been erected by Mr. Richard **SMITH**, an enterprising gentleman who has recently settled here, and his constant improvements are still going on.

We will now go around pass the depot of the Oxford & Henderson Railroad, and view the handsome and commodious residence of Prof. J. H. **HORNER** & Sons, co-principal of the "Horner Military School." The out buildings are the academy and barracks, and it almost makes one wish to be a school boy, just to look at the spacious and tastefully ornamented grounds. We will now turn back, and driving past the stream grist mill owned by Mr. J. A. **WHITE**, and all these great factories and warehouses, we go around by the parsonage and the Presbyterian Church, soon to be enlarged and renovated. I will say here, that there are nine resident ministers of the Gospel in Oxford, and the pulpits of each denomination are filled by most able and attractive divines.

We are now approaching another spacious and handsome structure, surrounded by extensive and richly ornamented grounds. This is "The Oxford Female Seminary," in charge of Prof. **HOBGOOD**, whose handsome, genial face is enough in itself to make the school popular and his corps of assistants is unsurpassed for highest culture and thorough competency. Here are many more handsome private residences, but we will

now go past the Baptist Church, and turn down Main Street, at the head of which stands among trees and flowers the beautiful home of A. H. A. **WILLIAMS**, Esq.. On either side are many new and elegant private houses, until we come to the busy center of the town. There stands the Oxford Bank Building, solid and imposing, erected and owned by Dr. Henry Herndon **FURTNER** on upon the same side, but far back from the broad and pleasant street, stands among the trees and shrubbery his beautiful private residence.

And now we come to the rich and ever attractive display of stores. Let us stop before one of them. The name on the glass door is "A. **LANDIS**." He has two handsome sons with him in business, and his clerks are all courteous and obliging gentlemen, (which is certainly characteristic of all the Oxford salesmen), and in this, as well as in the many other large stores, they are so numerous and so busy that one can almost imagine himself in one of the grand emporiums of New York. There across the street is the handsome hardware store of Messrs. **EDWARDS & ROGERS**, and then come the handsome and richly furnished drug store, which are always attractive, with the elegant and costly soda fountains and the various wares that are so inviting to the eye as well as to the palate. We have already passed the Methodist church with its towering steeple, and reaching the corner near Mr. **CRAWFORD'S** drug store, we will turn down into Commercial Avenue. Conspicuous up on the left is the elegant clothing store of the **KRONHEIMERS**, father and sons, and it is a first class reliable house. At the further end of this broad street is the beautiful home of Oxford's dead. The cemetery is not large, but is tastefully laid out, and is well care for by the ladies.

Now we will turn to the right and soon we approach such an array of new and costly looking houses, on either side of the new "Broadway," that it looks as if we had come into the midst of another town. Nearly every one of these buildings and lots are owned by one citizen, the wealthy and enterprising, Mr. B. H. **COZART**. That palatial home in course of erection on the hill beyond is to be his personal residence, (and it is whispered that a lovely bride will soon be nestled there – but this is confidential.)

The health of this beautiful, thrifty young city, with its broad streets, its fine water, wholesome air and lovely shade trees, is unsurpassed. And now that there is no whiskey sold within its limits, we have quiet, peaceful nights, and the attendance at the different churches has been greatly increased. The Young Mens' Christian Association, is a new and most desirable features in its social element, and will doubtless be an active power for good to the entire city. The society of Oxford is refined, cultivated and delightful. The physicians are skillful and attentive when their services are needed, and are a most genial and pleasant set of gentlemen, as are also the able and learned members of the legal profession. The boarding houses are first class, and are like pleasant homes to their patrons. Among them the house of the kind and genial, Mrs. Lucy **CURRIN** is one of the most popular. When the new railroad is completed, Oxford will be brought into quick and direct communication with Richmond on the north, and Durham on the west, and in all probability its population will be trebled within the next two years.

Now let us drive round to the cozy and pleasant "**OSBORN** House," where everybody is made comfortable and happy, and its genial landlord will give us all the news from the

churches, and he will lend us the Oxford Torchlight to read - a most excellent paper and ably edited. There is also the "Orphan's Friend," a good paper full of interesting matter and well edited. The work of type setting and printing is all done by the orphan boys withing the asylum building.

Now isn't Oxford a good place to live in? Very many come, and but few ever leave this beautiful, healthful, busy young city.

Gingerbread Men

2 cups pack brown sugar
1 ½ cups butter softened
1 egg
4 cups all purpose flour
2 teaspoons ground cinnamon
1 teaspoon ground nutmeg
½ teaspoon ground cloves
¼ teaspoon baking soda

Cream sugar and butter; add egg. Beat till light and fluffy. Stir flour with spices and soda; add to creamed mixture. Mix well. Cover; chill dough about 2 hours. On floured surface, roll dough to ⅛ inch thickness. Cut with a gingerbread man cutter. Place on Un-greased cookie sheet. Bake at 350 degrees till lightly browned 8 to 10 minutes. Cool 1 to 2 minutes; remove to rack. If desired decorate with purchased decorator icing. Makes about 72.

The Granville Institute

A Deservedly Popular School for Young Ladies

This school for young ladies we have had occasion before to commend to our readers. It is now well known and so well established here in Oxford that we hardly think it is necessary to do more than simply to mention the fact that it is a school conducted on a high plane of instruction. The persons who patronize this school are among the best people and the girls always acquit themselves with great credit at the commencement exercises. 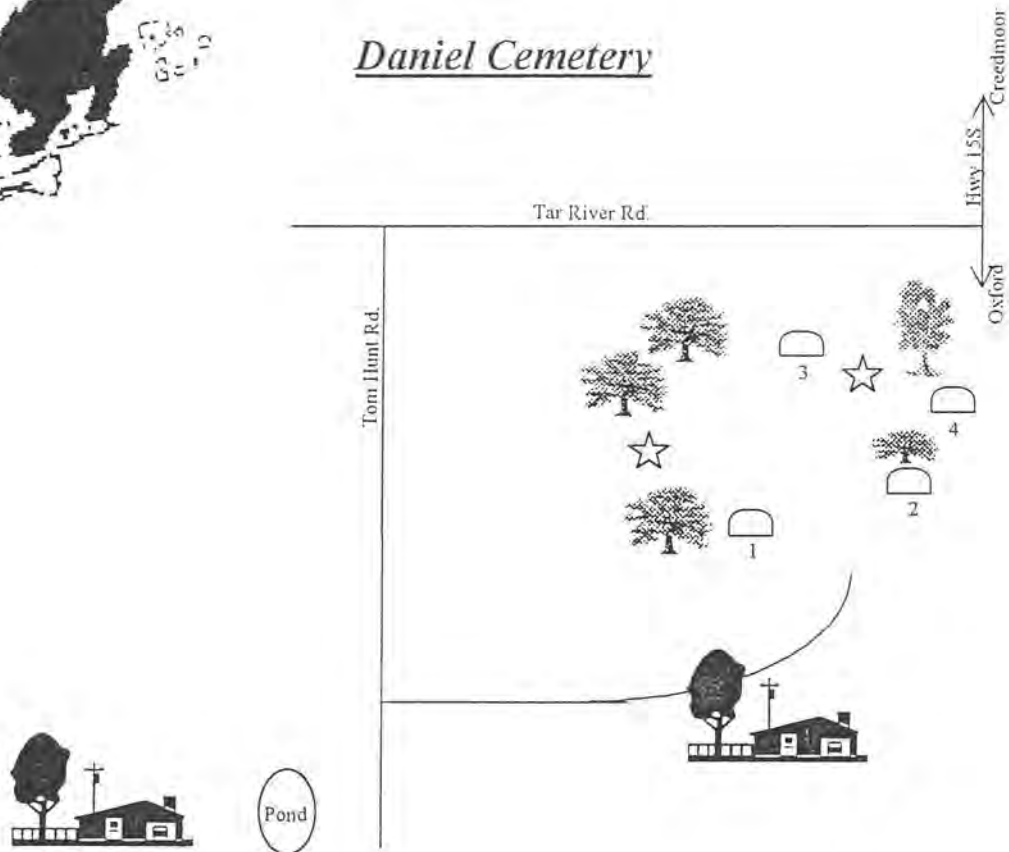

Oxford Torchlight, November 2, 1886

About three o'clock Friday morning the alarm of fire startled the sleeping inhabitants of the town.

The bedroom in the rear of the store occupied by H. S. **LOWERY**, Esq., was discovered to be on fire, having already made considerable headway. The bed in which Mr. **LOWERY** was sleeping was on fire. He made his escape, however, unhurt. The fire spread rapidly to the adjoining buildings and in a short while that whole portion of the town between Main Street and the railroad from Mason Street down to Hillsboro road was utterly destroyed.

The following are the losses as nearly as can be estimated at present, while the fire is still burning and several safes are in the burning debris and their contents are in unknown condition.

H. S. **FURMAN**, lost on building, stock, \$2,000; no insurance.

All the valuable matter in the post office department was saved.

J. **LOPIANSKY** lost on stock \$2,000, no insurance.

S. C. **VANN** lost, including two buildings, \$7,000, with \$2,000 insurance.

H. S. **LOWERY** lost \$1,000, no insurance.

Mrs. A. M. **WALL**, including building, \$8,000.

J. D. **JOYNER**, assignee, lost on drugs \$1,500.

A. B. **WESTER & Bro.**, lost chiefly on damage to goods removed estimated at \$3,000.

I. G. **STAUNTON**, two buildings \$5,000, no insurance.

Melville **DORSEY**, one building, \$800.

Mrs. C. V. **MASSENBURG**, loss on stock of millinery in moving slight.

CAUDELL & KELLY, had \$3,500 in stock, \$1,000 in insurance, greater part burned and damaged

J. A. **PORTER**, butcher, about \$100.

R. W. **MANGUM & Co.**, \$500.

W. L. **MCGHEE**, one building, occupied by R. W. **MANGUM & Co.**, \$400.

W. N. **HARRIS**, one building, \$700.

B. G. **LONG**, \$500.

T. B. **THARRINGTON**, \$750; no insurance.

D. H. **WHITFIELD**, one building \$1,000.

MASSENBURG and **GREEN**, about \$600. In the warehouse occupied by them was stored between one hundred and fifty and two hundred tons of fertilizers.

LISTER Bros., of Newark, N. J., lose seventy-five or a hundred tons. The loss on goods stored there will probably reach \$6,000, no insurance.

The building was owned by **BALLARD & CHEATHAM**, worth about \$2,000.

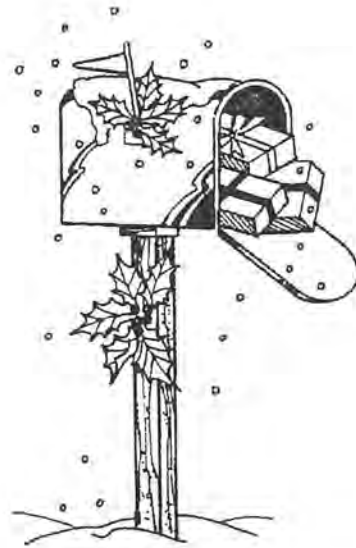
GEORGE THE SECOND by the Grace of the **KING OF GREAT BRITAIN:**

Order to the Sheriff to summon jurors to attend a court to be held at the house of William **EATON** on the first Tuesday in March 1748.

Colonel William **EATON** lived three or four miles from Henderson and the earliest courts of the county were held there. Later the courts were held at Harrisburg and still later at Oxford.

Main Street, Oxford, 1897

March 4, 1930

There were no streets in Oxford at that time which were hardsurface. The streets running into Main were the same as they are now. There was no monument at that time. Where the Long Company is, that store looked very much the same. The Hub store now looked very much like it did before it was remodeled a year or so ago. In the next line of stores was the Public Ledger office, which, I suppose, was the first office. This was where the 5-10 Cent Store is. I do not know what store was where Taylor Bros. is now but there was a hardware store a little further down.

On the other side was the Courthouse, which looked the same that it does now except that it had two doors into it.

Where the Brown Building now is were some wooden buildings, a little farther down. I think Landis and Easton had a store in a wooden building. The Bank Building was looking just the same as it looks now. The Masonic Building also looks the same except the storefronts were different and it had a red wall. There was a wooden store where Foreman's now stands. There were trees along in front of the stores and a well in front of the present store of Long's.
