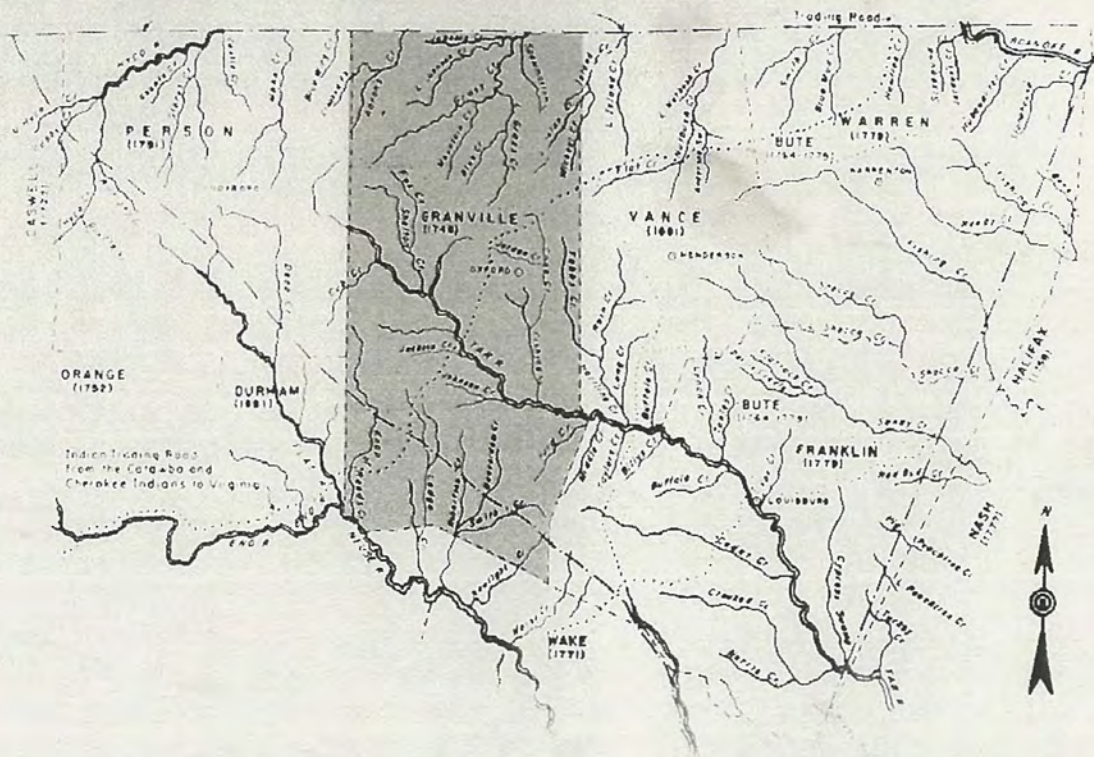

State Census of 1786

Granville County

The State Census conducted between 1784 and 1787 was as a whole not successful for North Carolina.¹ However for Granville County this census remains a very important document in family research, genealogy, and local history. This enumeration of Granville County appears to be an accurate enrollment of the people and is complete.² This is good news because the population schedule for the 1790 U.S. Federal Census for Granville County has not survived for researchers to use today. Tax Lists that are suggested as substitutes for the missing Federal returns are limited in scope and do not provide insight into the family make-up.

Mrs. Alvaretta Kenan Register has published a transcription of the State Census under the title **State Census of North Carolina, 1784-1787** (2d edition, rev., 1971; reprinted ed., Baltimore Genealogical Publishing Co., 1978). This second edition serves as an aid in using the State Census. Often this book can be used in place of the origin records.³ She has done a good job of identify individuals in the census; the index of names is also helpful. A review of this work shows that head-of-households were enumeration by tax districts within the counties where the census was taken. Statistical information was determined for each household in 5 specified categories—a) White males aged 21 -60; b.) White males under 12 and over 60; c.) White females of every age; d.) Blacks of both sexes aged 12-50; and e.) Blacks of both sexes under 12 and over 50. In Granville County the State enumeration was conducted during the summer of 1786. At that time, the county was subdivided into 15 different tax districts.⁴

For Granville County research, it is helpful to understand the following abnormal situations when using Mrs. Register's book of the State Census.

- The Beverdam district of Granville County is out of place in the book. The Beaverdam district that appears in Tyrrell County on pages 159 and 160 of the book is actually part of Granville County, is misplaced, and belongs with the other Granville County entries.
- The "Undesignated district" (both pg.1 and pg 2) on page 55 and ongoing at the top of page 56 of the book is part of the Henderson tax district and is a continuation of that same district shown on page 51.
- The remaining part of the "Undesignated district" starting about one-third down the left column on page 56 is the Fort Creek district. The Fort Creek district was not named in the book.
- The subtotals and cross footing shown within the transcription should not be trusted.
- Although the intent was to count White and Black individuals separately in the State Census, in most cases, the enumerators counted all free individual in the "White" category and only slaves in the "Black" category. Free Black people were generally counted in the census in the "White" category.
